"It is God's will that we take the Gospel into the world" (Mark 16:15)

Pray for:

- commitment and courage for all believers to be obedient (Rom 1:16)
- wisdom and discernment as we share the Gospel (1Peter 3:15-16)
- insight to see the opportunities to share as they come our way
- God to challenge believers to work in his fields wherever that may be – at home or in the nations. (Matt 9:37b)

"It is God's will that a oneness be seen among his people so that the lost will believe." (John 17:20-21)

Pray for:

- unity in the body of Christ (the church) (1Cor 12:12-13)
- that members of the body will use the gifts of the Spirit that he has freely given (1Cor 12:4-7)
- strong, godly leadership in the church
- that all will speak out against evil wherever we find it. (Eph 5:11)

In times past God worked his will through ungodly leaders (2Chron 36:22) He specifically tells us to pray for those in authority (1 Tim 2:2-4)

Pray for:

- our political leaders in all levels of government – local councils, state and federal parliaments
- wisdom for all in positions of authority in every area that affects our lives and our opportunities to share the Gospel
